### Wednesday, November 12

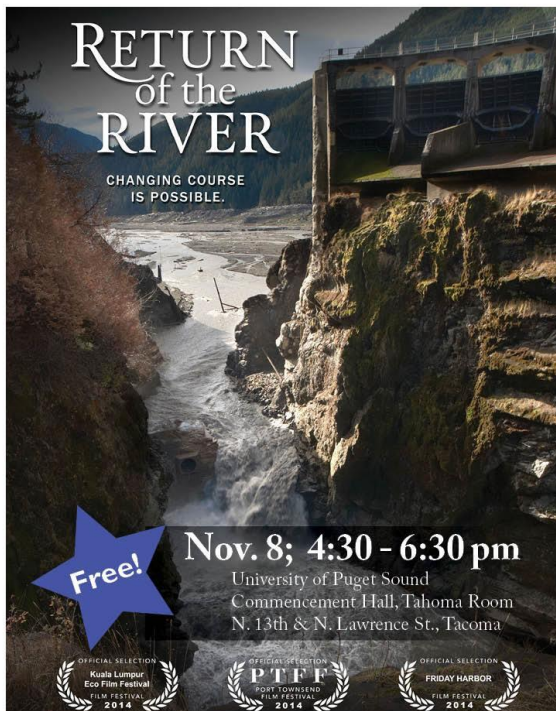
#### Did you know Pierce County's Land Use regulations, its community plans, and the county Comprehensive Plan are being rewritten?
